


PREVAILING WEATHER SYSTEMS



Low Pressure Area (LPA)

- 200 km East Northeast of Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (10.4°N, 127.2°E)
- Southwest Monsoon affecting the western sections of Southern Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.
