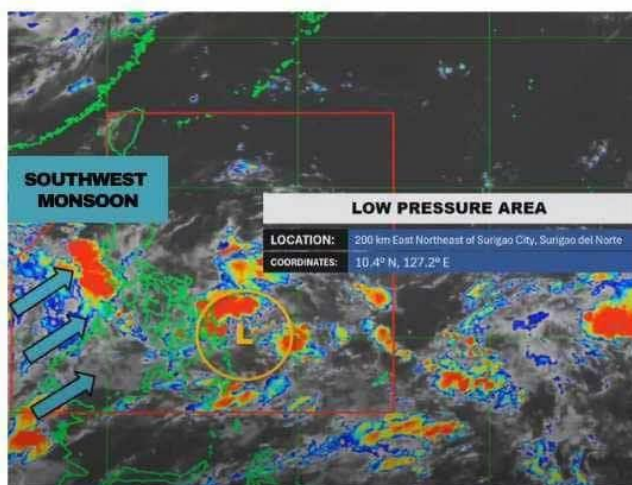




## PREVAILING WEATHER SYSTEMS



- **Low Pressure Area (LPA)**  
200 km East Northeast of Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (10.4°N, 127.2°E)
- **Southwest Monsoon affecting the western sections of Southern Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.**

## FORECAST WEATHER CONDITIONS

Region/Province	Weather System	Effects
Bicol Region, Eastern Visayas, Northern Mindanao, Caraga, Davao Region, Isabela, Aurora, Quezon, Marinduque, and Romblon	LPA	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms
The rest of MIMAROPA, Visayas, and Mindanao	Southwest Monsoon	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms
Metro Manila and the rest of CALABARZON	Southwest Monsoon	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms
The rest of Luzon	Localized Thunderstorms	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms
