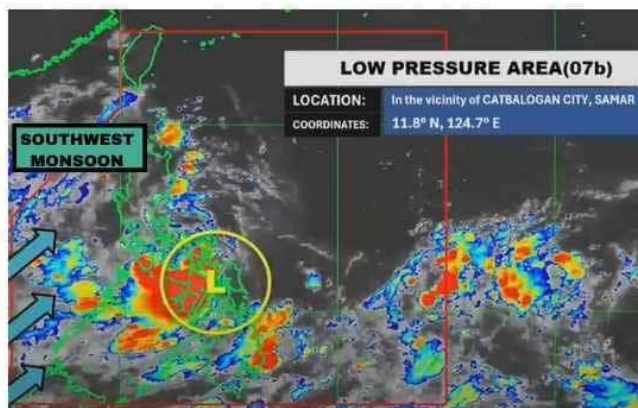




PREVAILING WEATHER SYSTEMS



- **Low Pressure Area (LPA)**
 In the vicinity of Catbalogan City, Samar (11.8°N, 124.7°E)
- **Southwest Monsoon**
 affecting the western sections of Southern Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.

FORECAST WEATHER CONDITIONS

Visayas, Bicol Region, Caraga, Marinduque, and Romblon	LPA	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms
Cagayan, Isabela, Quirino, Aurora, Bulacan, Laguna, Rizal, and Quezon	Trough of LPA	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms
Metro Manila, Bataan, Zamboanga Peninsula, BARMM, Northern Mindanao, and the rest of CALABARZON and MIMAROPA	Southwest Monsoon	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms
